Access Project Experience - LNG

Gas Giant

LNG is still seen as the biggest growth area and opportunity in the oil and gas industry, particularly as demand grows for alternate energy sources. Because of its long history and experience in the oil and gas industry, Australia has the capability to provide expertise, equipment and services to the LNG sector. Here at Access Group we are looking forward to being able to bring our market leading service to these new projects.

LNG Projects - The oil and gas industry is a major contributor to the Australian economy. In 2006-07 the industry accounted for about 3.8 per cent of the total GDP. Australia's biggest export in the industry is LNG. Australia is now the 18th largest producer of natural gas, the seventh largest exporter of LNG in the world and the third largest LNG exporter in the Asia-Pacific Region. This has led to a great deal of expansion and new construction opportunities that Access Group have been preferred supplier to.

North West Shelf – Project Expansion – 5th LNG Train
Commissioning is due in Quarter 4 2008 and first LNG export cargoes are also planned for Q4 2008. The fifth train will boost the north West Shelf project's total LNG production capacity to 16.3 Mt/a. Completion of stabiliser plant 2009.

Pluto - Woodside Project

Woodside's A\$12 billion Pluto LNG Project is set to become the fastest developed LNG project from discovery of the gas field in 2005 to first gas in late 2010. Approved for development in July 2007, the foundation project will process gas from the Pluto and Xena gas fields, located in the Carnarvon Basin about 190 km north-west of Karratha, Western Australia.

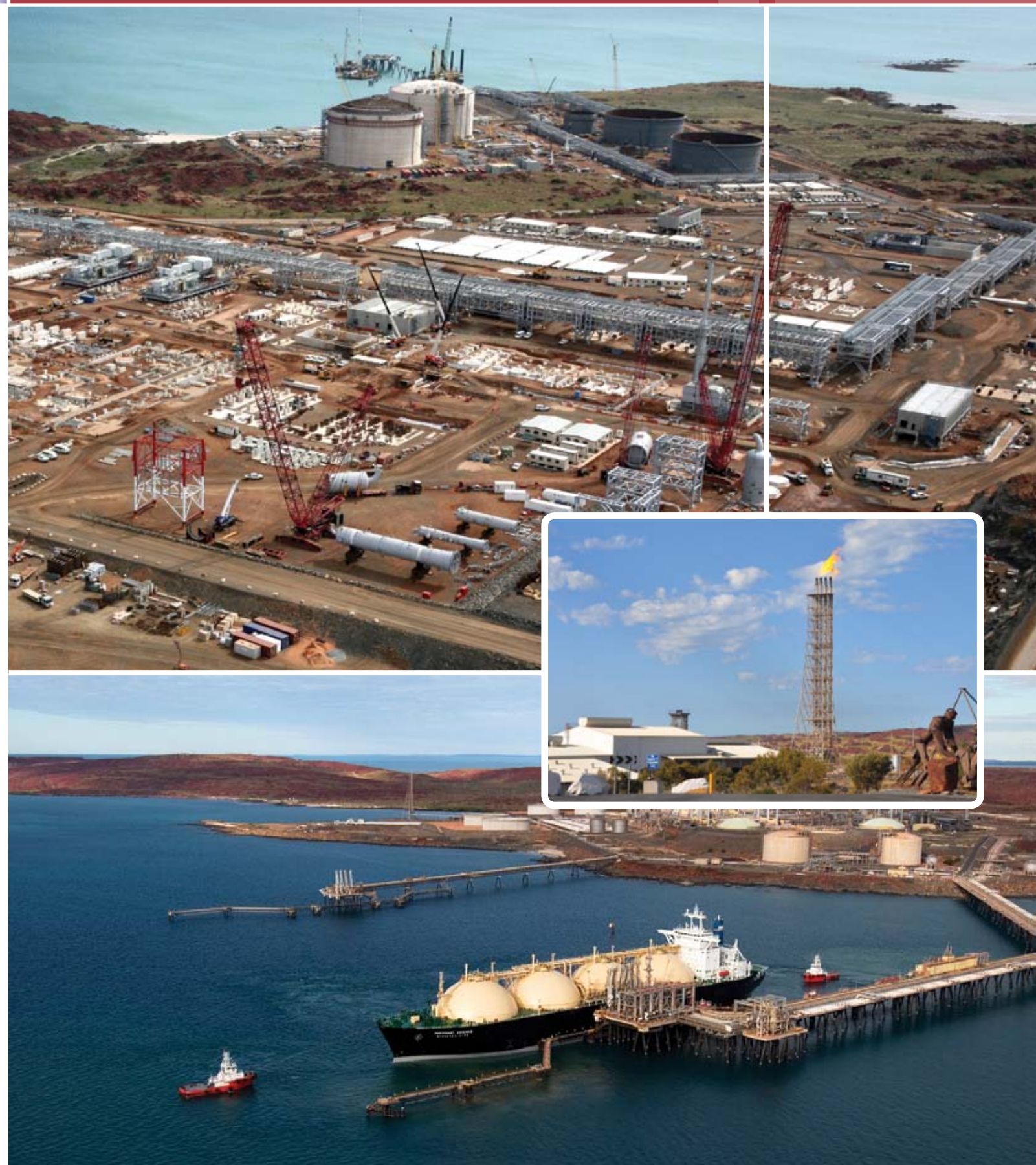
The Pluto LNG Project is underpinned by 15-year sales agreements with Kansai Electric and Tokyo Gas. Both companies became project participants in January 2008, each acquiring a 5% interest in the foundation project. With construction of the foundation project progressing, Woodside is preparing for expansion with a second and third LNG train and pipeline gas facility.

CBI - LNG Stabilizer Phase V

CB&I was the mechanical erection contractor for construction of a fifth liquefied natural gas (LNG) production train with a design capacity of 4.2 million tonnes per year. The Phase V expansion increased the plant's capacity to 15.9 million tonnes per year, making it one of the single largest LNG complexes in the Asia-Pacific region and had an on-site work force that peaked at about 850 employees.



With LNG projects ramping up nation wide, our previous experience as preferred supplier to many major projects puts us in a good position for the future as we know what is required to deliver superior service.

- Iron Ore

Our national coverage and years of industry experience have made dealing in remote sites one of our areas of specialty.

The Big Picture

One of the benefits in offering our customers the complete service solution is that we can control all the aspects of our business process. This translates into quick turn around times on service and equipment hire issues despite the remote nature of some projects. With our nationwide reach and market leading support, issues of distance and time are greatly reduced.

Iron Ore Projects - In Australia, iron ore ranks as the second largest mineral industry after coal, making it one of our most exported minerals. This high demand means that there is constant expansion and construction of new iron ore mines and facilities. Access Group has been the preferred supplier for EWP and access equipment for the most prominent of these expansions and new construction projects around Australia.

Mid West Region – Koolanooka Hematite Iron Ore Mine

Midwest Corporation commenced transporting iron ore fines from stockpiles at Koolanooka, about 160km southeast of Geraldton, in January 2006, with the first exports shipped in February 2006.



Kwinana – Hismelt Commercial Iron Making Plant

Hismelt Corporation, in a joint venture with Nucor (25%), Mitsubishi (10%) and Shougang (5%), has developed a commercial-scale Hismelt process plant at Kwinana, near Perth. The first stage of the plant is designed to produce 800,000 t/a of pig iron from iron ore fines, coal and fluxes.



Pilbara – Cape Preston – Iron Ore Processing

CITIC Pacific, a Chinese company, is planning the development of a magnetite iron ore mine and pellet plant with a capacity of 6 Mt/a. A concentrator, pellet plant, slurry pipeline, port facilities, 240 MW power station and desalination plant will be built at Cape Preston, as well as accommodation facilities.



Mid West Region – Extension Hill Hematite Mine

Mount Gibson Iron has environmental approval for a 2 Mt/a hematite mining operation at Extension Hill, 330km southwest of Geraldton. The ore will be railed to the port of Geraldton for export.

No Preference

Working in remote locations can prove challenging for some companies, but here at Access Group we saw it as an opportunity to expand our area of expertise. Today we are specialists in providing superior service to not only metro areas but remote projects where the temperatures reach in excess of 55 degrees. We have developed a team of professionals that excel in these environments.



Pilbara – Brockman 4 Iron Ore Mine

Hamersley Iron is developing the Brockman 4 Iron Ore deposit. Construction work has commenced and commissioning is expected in 2010. Full capacity of 22 Mt/a is expected to be reached in 2012. Additionally Hamersley Iron is well advanced in its construction work to expand the capacity of its port facilities at Dampier Port from 120 Mt/a to 145 Mt/a. This work included installation of a new car dumper, screen house and related facilities.



Pilbara – Cape Lambert Port Expansion

Robe River Mining is planning to expand the capacity of its port facilities at Cape Lambert, east of Karratha. The expansion will lift the iron ore export capacity of the facilities to 85 MT/a.



Pilbara – Rapid Growth Project 4

In March 2007, BHP Billiton announced its Board approval for Rapid Growth Project 4 ("RGP4"), which will increase system capacity across its Pilbara Iron Ore operations by 26t Mt/a to 155 Mt/a at a cost of US\$2.6 billion. RGP4 includes development of a new crushing and screening plant, as well as additional stockyards, car dumping and train loading facilities at whaleback. Infrastructure upgrades will also be implemented at satellite ore bodies and the rail and port operations. Work has started and initial production is expected to commence in the first half of 2010, with ramp-up to full capacity expected to be achieved by the end of 2012.



Mid West Region – Weld Range Iron Ore

Midwest Corporation proposes to develop a 15-20 Mt/a iron ore mine at Weld Range 65km southwest of Meekatharra, producing a mix of hermalite lump and fines. The project is expected to utilise a new rail line and a new deep water port facility at Oakajee.



As Australian mining landscape continues to expand into the northwest, so does Access Groups infrastructure and capabilities in the area of remote project specialisation.

- Iron Ore Continued

A Long Term View

Having worked with some clients on several consecutive projects has allowed us to develop strong working relationships. This in turn leads to an increase in our ability to tailor our service to our clients requirements and project needs.

Pilbara – Rapid Growth Project 5

In February 2008, BHP Billiton approved the RGP5 iron ore expansion. This work includes the expansion of Port Hedland's inner harbor by constructing two new berths and ship loading facilities at Harriet Point. Construction is planned for 2009, with operation by mid 2010. It will also increase the rail capacity to 300 Mt/a by duplication of the railway track between the Yandi mine and Port Hedland. This work commenced in May 2008. RGP5 is scheduled to be completed by mid 2010.



Pilbara – Cape Preston – Mine and Pellet Plant

This project has an Iron Ore Processing (Mineralogy Pty Ltd) Agreement based on the development of Mineralogy Pty Ltd's Fortescue magnetite deposits, located near Cape Preston, 70km southwest of Dampier. Mineralogy has sold subsidiary companies with right-to-mine agreements to two purchasing companies, CITIC Pacific Ltd and Australasian Resources, which are planning the development of separate projects under the Mineralogy State Agreement. Australian Resources Ltd has announced an agreement with Shougang Corporation which will fund the project development, with Australasian keeping a 50% interest.



Pilbara – Iron Ore Mine Rail and Port Development

FMG Chichester operates a 45 Mt/a iron ore mine at Cloud Break in the Chichester Ranges of the Eastern Pilbara. The mine is serviced by a multi-user railway and new port facilities at Port Hedland. The project is being commissioned. First exports commenced in May 2008.



Pilbara – Rapid Growth Project 3

The US\$1.5 billion Rapid Growth Project 3 ("RGP3") expansion to increase capacity of BHP Billiton's iron ore operations in the Pilbara to 129 Mt/a was completed in Q4 2007. The key elements of RGP3 comprise the expansion of the Area C mine by 20 Mt/a, additional sidings on the Newman railway, and port works at Nelson Point and Finucane.



Developing our own infrastructure in the North West Shelf and Pilbara regions has allowed us to maintain our market leading service regardless of the distances and logistics involved.



Access Project Experience - Aluminum & Titanium

Light and Strong

There are currently five bauxite mines in Australia providing feedstock for the seven aluminum refineries, which in turn supply alumina to the six Australian aluminium smelters and the export market.

Australia is the largest producer of bauxite in the world, with 67million tones produced per annum.

Aluminum - Australia produces about 40% of world bauxite and more than 30% of world alumina, making it the largest producer of bauxite and alumina. Bauxite is mined from open cut operations at Weipa (QLD), Gove (NT), and the Darling Range (WA). There are very large bauxite deposits in the Mitchell Plateau and Cape Bougainville regions of Western Australia. Access Group has been the preferred supplier to many of these major sites.

Wagerup/Willowdale – Refinery Train 3 Expansion

Alcoa is investigating the feasibility of a third production train expansion at its Wagerup alumina refinery to increase capacity up to 4.7 Mt/a. On 14th September 2006, the Minister for the Environment approved the expansion proposal.



Worsley/Boddington – Alumina Refinery Expansion

BHP Billiton announced in May the go-ahead for the \$2.5 billion Efficiency and Growth Expansion project at its Worsley Alumina refinery. The expansion project will lift capacity of the refinery from 3.5 Mt/a through expanded mining operations, additional refining capacity and upgraded port facilities. The construction phase will start immediately and first production is expected in the first half of 2011.



Titanium - Australia supplies about 40 per cent of the world's ilmenite and about 25 per cent of its rutile. In contrast to its dominance in other minerals, Australia supplies only about a 3 per cent share of the world's titanium dioxide pigment production of around 4 million tonnes. Regardless of its small role in the mining landscape, Access Group has been involved in the major projects in this industry.

Kwinana – Titanium Dioxide Pigment Plant Expansion

Tiwest, through its joint venture partners Tronox Incorporated and Exxaro Resources, has environmental approval for an expansion that will see a 36% ramp-up in production from the plant's current capacity of 110,000 tpa to around 150,000 tpa in a bid to take advantage of the strong demand for titanium oxide in the Asia-Pacific region. Construction started in 2008 with additional capacity to come online in early 2010. A decision to proceed with further stages within this approved expansion is dependent on market conditions.



Although we have in excess of a thousand machines in the north west region already, we are continuing to increase our fleet in the area, along with the relevant infrastructure to support it.



Access Project Experience - Gold

Goldrush

Today the gold industry is well established and instead of hundreds of gold miners panning for gold in riverbeds and creeks, the work is done by huge machines that screen & mill through mountains of rock, extracting microscopic amounts of the precious metal. As little as three grams per tone is now considered a payable amount.

Gold - After coal, iron ore, and crude petroleum, gold currently ranks fourth in value of all Australian merchandise exports. Despite this, there have been a series of expansions to existing mines along with the commissions of new mines around the country. We have been privileged to be the preferred supplier to many of these, of particular note is Boddington in WA and Olympic Dam in SA:

Boddington – Gold Mine (Wandoo Expansion)

BGM Management Company Pty Ltd, on behalf of Newmont and AngloGold Ashanti, is developing the Wandoo project, based on mining the extensive bedrock resource that underlies the mined-out oxide resource. Production will be up to 600,000 oz/a of gold and about 20,000 t/a copper in concentrates over a 17-year mine life. Initial production started late 2008.



Prominent Hill – Gold Mine

Prominent Hill is the site of a major copper and gold mine in north west South Australia which has been developed by OZ Minerals. The deposit is an iron oxide copper gold style mineralization. The mine has cost over AUD 1 billion to develop, and it is projected to produce 100,000 tones of copper and 115,000 oz of gold in concentrates a year. The mine went into production in the second half of 2008. The development includes an open-pit mine, a conventional grinding and flotation processing plant, construction of a permanent village to accommodate the workforce and construction of a haulage road, power line and bore field. Studies for underground development are underway.



Olympic Dam – Gold & Copper Mine

Olympic Dam is a mining centre in South Australia. The Olympic Dam expansion completed the pre-feasibility stage during 2008, and the first step of expansion is scheduled for completion by late 2013. Further development is planned to take the mine production rate to some 72 million tones per year and 730,000 tones copper, 19,000 tones of uranium oxide and 25 t of gold per year.



With WA being the largest of the states, we have become very proficient with logistic and support issues as we have had years of practice in delivering service and equipment to remote areas.



Access Project **Experience** - Water Treatment

Think Big

There are a number of canal and pipeline proposals to pump water from Western Australia's Kimberley region to Perth. Each involves up to 3,700 kilometers of infrastructure drawing water from the Fitzroy River but all travel different routes, including plans to supply water to Kalgoorlie as well.

Water Treatment - With water an already scarce resource in Australia there has been an increase in projects designed to expand this limited resource throughout Australia. Projects such as desalination plants and a range of water treatment plants have been commissioned Australia wide. Access Group has been involved in the construction and expansion of such projects throughout WA and SA.

Thiess Kentz – Woodman Point

Thiess Kentz has just finished the installation of instrument/electrical equipment for the odour control facility at Woodman Point waste water treatment plant in WA. In addition they also installed instrumentation and electrical equipment associated with the chemical treatment, chemical storage and BioWay section of Woodman point waste water treatment odour control facility.



Thiess Kentz – Beenyup Projects

Thiess Kentz have completed the installation of instrumentation and electrical equipment for the new secondary sedimentation tanks on the W2WA site in Beenyup in February 2009. Additionally in July 2009 Thiess Kentz completed the installation and commission of elect / instrumentation equipment for the W2WA group water replenishment trial at Beenyup.



The Alkimos Wastewater Scheme

An Alliance between the Water Corporation and the private sector was formed in December 2006 for the design and construction of the Alkimos Wastewater Treatment Scheme. The Alkimos Water Alliance is a commercial venture involving the Water Corporation and a joint venture between Brookfield Multiplex, McMahon Contractors and Züblin and various other sub-contractors. The Alliance brings together experts in the fields of engineering, procurement, construction and management.



As new WA water solutions are put forward and projects commissioned, Access Group's WA background and experience puts us in good stead for future project requirements.

- Power Stations

Safety First

Safety is an important issue on all work sites but doubly so when dealing with sites that are naturally more dangerous, such as high voltage power stations and substations. Access Group's long standing and highly regarded safety standards and training help to reduce the associated dangers and ensure safe work environments.

Power Stations - Australia's continuing growth and expansion has placed a greater demand on reliable infrastructure, particularly in finding renewable and cost effective forms of energy. The power industry has already begun to explore new options to meet these demands and Access Group has been involved in a host of projects designed to meet these needs.

Collie – Bluewaters 1 Coal-Fired Power Stations

Griffin Energy is constructing the first of two 208 MW coal-fired power stations at the proposed Coolangatta industrial estate, 10km northeast Collie. Commissioning of the Bluewaters 1 base load power station is expected by late 2008.



Horizon Power

Horizon Power has commenced work to build the most efficient gas-fired power station on the Pilbara's North West Interconnected System (NWIS). The site of the power station is situated next to Horizon Power's Head Office in Karratha on land owned by Horizon Power and directly adjacent to Horizon Power's 132KV substation, giving it a direct link into the local network. This power station will bring added security to the rapidly-growing North West Interconnected System. The new power station will be built to an initial capacity of 86MW but will be designed to grow to meet the growing needs of the region.



Western Power - Kwinana Power Station Upgrade

The existing Kwinana to South Fremantle 132kV transmission line was upgraded in 2007. The upgrade was to provide a consistent and reliable power supply to the South Fremantle substation, including reliable power while repairs and maintenance work are carried out. The transmission line was upgraded from split-phase to dual circuit, with the existing overhead earth wire to be replaced with an optical fibre ground wire (OPGW). The OPGW incorporates the functions of both an earth wire and communication fibres, which now connects the Kwinana Power Station with the South Fremantle substation, improving communication links and regional power output.



Working with major infrastructure providers such as Western Powers has given us an insight into how to best manage our own infrastructure needs.



Access Project Experience - Nickel

Western Australia's position as world leaders in export of base metals and other natural recourse has allowed us to specialize in remote projects that the state is renowned for.

WA Experience

WA is Australia's leading state for mineral mining and export. WA's mining efforts have made Australia the world leader in exporting Iron Ore and other base metals. As Access Group is a WA founded company we have been in an ideal position to support the ongoing maintenance, expansion and construction that has made WA mining industry one of the best in the world.

Nickel - Currently, all of Australia's nickel production is from Western Australia. The Western Mining Corporation Ltd (WMC) discovered the first known important economic concentration of nickel in Australia in 1966 at Kambalda, 50km south of Kalgoorlie. Further exploration led to the discovery of many more orebodies in the Kambalda region and the field now produces a significant share of mine output. Access Group has been involved in the expansion and construction of many major sites, outlined below;

Ravensthorpe – Lateritic Nickel Mine

The project includes an open-cut mine and hydrometallurgical process plant using laterite ores. The plant will have the capacity to produce up to 50,000 t/a of contained nickel and 1400 t/a of cobalt in a mixed hydroxide intermediate product to be recovered at the company's Yabulu refinery in Queensland. Plant commissioning is underway, with the first shipment of product leaving Esperance in December 2007. The Ravensthorpe project was officially opened on 23 May 2008.

Goongarrie – Kalgoorlie Nickel Project

This project will involve a mine and hydrometallurgical processing plant at Goongarrie (about 85km north of Kalgoorlie) producing up to 50,000 t/a of nickel from laterite resources of 903 Mt grading 0.74% Ni and 0.05 Co. Heron and Vale Inco are undertaking a pre-feasibility study which is due for completion in January 2009. Further ore reserve estimation mine planning and metallurgical testing will be undertaken. The main focus will be on development of three flow sheet applications, leading to preliminary plant design, final flow sheet.

North Eastern Gold fields – Yakabindie Nickel Mine

The Yakabindie project is based on a large nickel deposit situated near BHP Billiton's existing Mt Keith nickel project and is estimated to contain a resource of 289 Mt at 0.58% nickel. BHPB is considering developing Yakabindie as an integrated part of the Mt Keith project, and is conducting a pre-feasibility study, including infill drilling of the ore body and metallurgical.

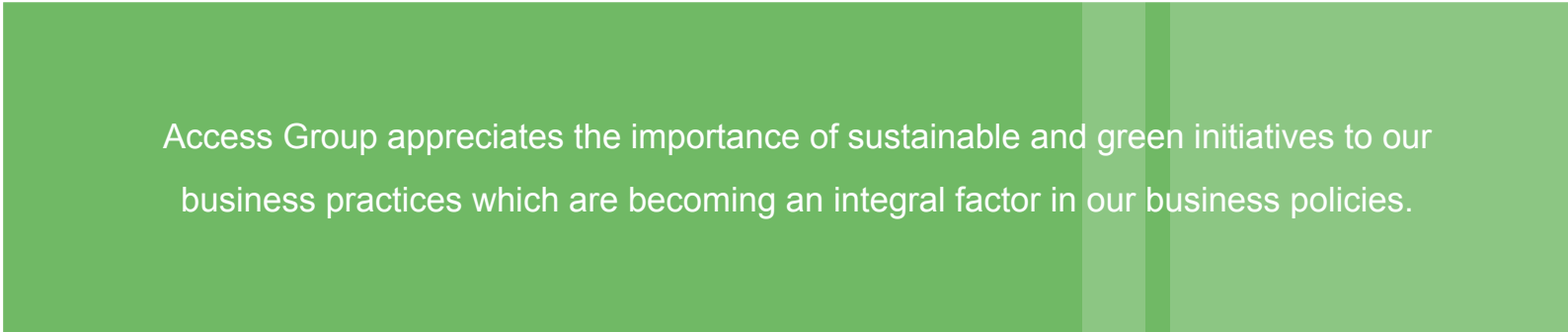

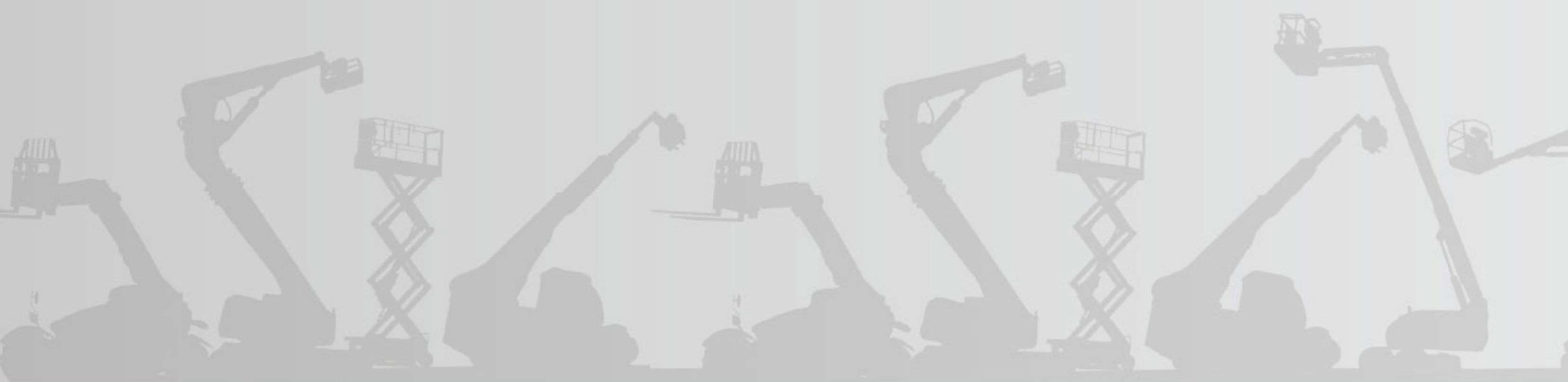
