CAPABILITY STATEMENT

Comac Equipment Pty Ltd is a Queensland owned and operated company providing civil construction and earth moving services. We have a strong focus on high quality road building and maintenance, as well as bulk earthworks projects. With a Head Office located in Toowoomba and sub-offices in Regional Queensland, Comac Equipment is well situated to provide services across South-West Queensland, Darling Downs and Surat Basin regions.

We have a modern fleet of John Deere graders which are supported by a team of highly experienced Final Trim Grader Operators. In addition to our Grader Fleet, we also have Semi Water Tankers (36,000L), 8 Wheelers (15,000L) and Heavy Rigid Water Tankers (13,500L). Our attention to detail ensures a high level of safety whilst at the same time delivering timely and high quality workmanship.

Comac Equipment's civil construction services cover:

- Highway construction and maintenance including flood restoration works.
- Bulk earthworks for site preparation and civil construction works.
- Site preparation and rehabilitation to minimise erosion.
- Carting potable and non-potable water to support civil construction, site facilities, dust suppression and camp facilities.
- Construction of Permanent & Temporary fencing to provide site/project security and designated boundaries.
- Qualified Traffic Controllers experienced in rural, remote and urban locations.
- Ability to carry out certain demolition works.
- **Technical advice** based on knowledge of the terrain, weather conditions and erosion to inform works planning and execution.
- Roads and fire breaks for graziers and oil and gas sites.
- Dam construction and maintenance including access ways and perimeter clearing.
- Clearing power line pathways and access points.
- 24 hour, 7 day a week access and support for clients. Teams can be deployed at short notice.
