All drivers are also required to obtain a valid Construction induction card prior to commencement of employment. Additional qualifications held by some drivers include Dangerous goods, High risk work and Gas detection and monitoring.</p>
Civil Construction	<p>All staff in the Civil Construction division hold a Certificate of competency in equipment operations as well as a Construction induction card.</p> <p>Supervisory staff have a minimum of 10 years experience in heavy equipment operation, while our Operations Manager has 30+ years experience.</p> <p>Penderbrae employs one apprentice in the Civil Construction division, who has five years operating experience prior to taking up an apprenticeship.</p>
